Camp Kintail 2024. Knox is once again offering Camperships and will pay 50% of the week-long camps and 75% of short-week camps. Campership forms are available on the table outside Rev. James' office. Please fill it out after registering your child with Camp Kintail (using Option 'B') and return it to the red box by June 2. If you have registered your child(ren) and do not submit the form by the 2<sup>nd</sup>, you will not be eligible for the Campership.

We are continuing our *Campership appeal*. We have 25 children registered to use the camperships this year which is a total of \$11,047.16 that we are sending to Camp Kintail to cover them. 
